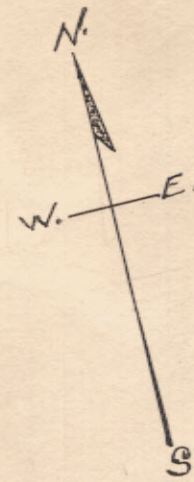


HAMILTON WARD. 3
