The following entry was made on the Journal of the Director of Highways November 1, 1954, Volume 39, Page 739.

BUTLER COUNTY - S.R. 732 - ABANDONMENT OF PART OF SECTION 10.35
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 29, 1954.

Pursuant to Section 1178-20 of the General Code, the Director of Highways on December 11, 1951, approved a change in location of a portion of S.R. 732, hearing having been held in Hamilton, Ohio, on November 14, 1951. This was recorded on Page 682, Volume 36, of the Journal of the Director of Highways. Said approval stated that the abandonment of the old highway would not be effective until the improvement of the new location was accepted and proper entry made in the Journal of the Director of Highways.

In view of the fact that the improvement of the above mentioned relocation has been accepted, Director Linzell orders that the Abandonment referred to in the above mentioned journal entry be effective as of October 29, 1954, and that said former location hereby reverts to the Butler County Highway System.
