PERFORMANCE BOND: Submitted by Fred G. Rickard and Fanny Rickard in the penal sum of \$9500.00 on Subdivision Rickard Acres Addition No. 2 in Sections 1 and 12, Town 2, Range 4, Madison Township, Butler County, Ohio, for completion of improvements in said subdivision to the satisfaction of the County Engineer. The following real estate shall be subject to the conditions of this obligation:

Situated in Section 12, Town 2, Range 4, Madison Township, Butler County, Ohio. Bonded and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center line of Trenton-Franklin Road south 77°-31' west, 327.37 feet from the point of intersection of the center line of said road and the West line (extended southwardly) of lot number 12, as the same is known and designated on the recorded plat of "RICKARD ACRES" a subdivision of land in the section, town and range aforesaid, which plat is recorded in Vol. 13, Page 16 of the Plat Records of Butler County, Ohio; thence, from said point of beginning, North 12°-29' west, 225.00 feet; thence south 77°-31' west, 75.00 feet; thence south 12°-29' east, 225.00 feet to the center line of Trenton-Franklin Road and thence along the center line of said road, north 77°-31' east, 75.00 feet to the point of beginning.
