With two white stakes, stake driveway location indicating the approximate width of the proposed driveway. (Minimum drive width – 10', Maximum drive width – 20'). NOTE: Consideration should be given for optimal sight distance when choosing a driveway location. 3. The County Engineer's Office will make an inspection of the proposed drive location to determine the size of the pipe and specifications for installation. 4. The County Engineer's Office will mail the applicant the permit and a drawing with driveway specifications and/or pipe installation instructions, and standards for mailbox installation. 5. After installing the pipe and driveway, please call the Butler County Engineer's Office at 785-4119 for a construction inspection. 6. When the driveway has passed the construction inspection, the permit will be released to the Butler County Building Department. 7. A third and final driveway inspection and mailbox inspection is required for Release of Occupancy Permit by the Butler County Building Department. Please call the Butler County Engineer's office at 785-4119 for an inspection. I, the undersigned, understand that the Butler County Engineer assumes no responsibility or liability for the work done under this permit and that all work shall be done at no cost to the County. All work shall be done as applicable, in accordance with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation Construction and Materials Specification, the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, and any supplemental and special provisions deemed necessary or as stated on the permit as special provisions or conditions. The County Engineer reserves the right to order the removal, reconstruction, relocation, or repair of any work performed under a permit at the owner's expense. The County Engineer or his representative may revoke or annul any permit or halt work at any time for non-compliance or non-performance of the conditions set f

Good afternoon, Jim.

The proposed access locations as shown on the attached file are approved as noted:

- 1. Cross access easement is obtained between Tract 1 and Tract 2 for the shared use of Access A;
- 2. The centerline of proposed Access A is located 500 feet from centerline of Hamilton Mason Road and the centerline of proposed Access B is located a minimum of 425 feet from proposed Access A;
- 3. Cross access easement is obtained between Tract 1 and existing parcel to the south of Tract 1;
- 4. Existing Access C is removed;
- 5. Connector road between existing parcel to south and proposed Access B drive is constructed as shown on attached file.
