- LVWC Elementary School
 - With the vertical issues and sight distance look improving the vertical alignment with the addition of a south bound turn lane.
 - Poles are on both sides of the roadway.
 - Klingers to look at the difference between one side widening and both.
 - ML TIS is not needed as long as improvements are done.
 - ML May need to look at radius improvements to Hamilton mason for bus traffic
 - School stated that the buses are making the trip now.
 - School does not have to pay prevailing wage so they could save money not contracting the construction to the county.
 - They want to be open fall 2008
 - GW We will look at fitting it into to our 2008 schedule.
 - GW- Make sure that safety is above and beyond the number one priority with buses and kids.
- Bethany Road Freshman School
 - Bethany signal was bumped to 2007 construction
 - o School
 - wants us to look at the pedestrian crossing mid block to cross over to the high school
 - Maybe look at lengthening the time the school flashers are going off.
 - ML We are very hesitant to push for a cross walk mid block
 - Need flashing signal at pedestrian request
 - Would need to add lighting to the crossing
 - Kliengers is to look at preliminary eng on punch through road.
 - Vert and horz alignment with sidewalk
 - Possible deflection at the intersection to force in sidewalk
